Brimington North	Having visited polling stations in both CA1 and CA2 on many polling days, they are seriously underused, making it frustrating that Henry Bradley Infant School must be closed for very little reason. The community centre could easily accommodate all those who do turn out to vote.	Henry Bradley Infant School is ideally located centrally in polling district CA2.  Moving electors from Henry Bradley Infant School to the Community Centre would result in an electorate of around 4000 at the Community Centre. Given the lack of parking around the Community Centre, I do not feel this is a reasonable change.
Brimington South	They should not be in schools	Polling stations are continuously under review to try and find alternative venues to schools. At present, we do not have alternative options in those polling districts where schools are used as polling stations.
Brampton East and Boythorpe	Think you need more, not everyone has cars	Where possible, polling districts are allocated to their own polling station. However, this isn't currently achievable in all areas due to the lack of suitable venues. Polling places are constantly under review, additional polling stations can be used should suitable venues be available in those areas where we have two polling districts at the same polling station.
