MODIFICATION ORDER, 2018

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Chesterfield Borough Council, in accordance with Section 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) has made the following order:

Chesterfield Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Chesterfield Modification Order, 2018.

The order comes into effect on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2018. It updates and modifies the Chesterfield Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Order, 2014 (as amended) by:

- removing the former North East Derbyshire District Council Car Park and Saltergate Multi-Storey Car Park (as no longer available)
- regulating car parking in the town centre area known as Park Road, Market Place, New Square and Low Pavement (no parking except by authorised vehicles), the parking place at St Helen's Street (restricts parking Monday to Saturday 9am until 5pm to 3 hours, no return within 3 hours) and the rear access road to Wardgate Way shops (no parking at any time).
- changing times of operation, charging and waiting periods (as appropriate) for car parks at Derbyshire Times Car Park, Hall Road, Old Ship Lane, Queen's Park South and Storrs Road.
- requiring payment of a release fee (in addition to any other charges due) on release from New Beetwell Street multi-storey car park outside its hours of operation
- substituting plans of some parking places as a result of more accurate mapping
- updating the names of some car parks.
